

Map Assignment

Provinces, Territories and Capital Cities of Canada

Reference: *The Canadian Oxford World Atlas*, 5th edition. Pages 10-11, or another atlas.

Locate the following places on the blank map of Canada found on the back of this page (or on the following page if you are downloading this assignment).

Value: 10 marks – based on accuracy, neatness and completion.

Your first and last name must appear prominently in the upper right hand corner.

Be sure to rough out your work lightly in pencil before completing it in pen. This map must be completed by hand and not done on a computer.

Colour coastlines in blue.

Colour each province distinctly. Do not repeat colours on provinces that border each other.

Colours should be even and applied neatly.

Be consistent in labeling. Provinces and territories should be labeled in the same way – why not use all capital letters to show importance. Cities should be labeled consistently, but differently to provinces and territories – such as by using upper and lower case to indicate that they are lesser to provinces in importance. City labels should be smaller than province labels.

All provinces, territories and cities should be labeled parallel to the bottom of the map.

Use dot symbols to identify each capital precisely. Use a distinct dot symbol to show the national capital.
